<u>General Manager</u>: We do, but advised that there is no provision for caretaker mode in Local Government Act.

16/96 <u>CIr. Poynter</u>: Also asked if some pre-working with constituent councils, on the synchronising the sharing of iPads.

<u>General Manager</u>: New Councillors will get new iPads, the current ones are approaching the end of their useful life.

Director of Engineering: Old ones handed down to staff.

16/97 <u>CIr. Funnell</u>: Asked about the proposed new Levee Bank. WWCC designing 1:100 year around City, has RWCC factored that into it?

<u>Director of Engineering</u>: No, an increase to North Wagga's levee has not been factored into our design. However, the RWCC levee design includes a 500mm freeboard which may accommodate the upstream effects. It's a decision we would make if the North Wagga proposal were to become reality.

Clr. Funnell: Is there room to move in our design?

Director of Engineering: Yes

16/98 <u>CIr. Braid</u>: Thanked staff of Riverina Water County Council for making her welcome, with Pat setting up iPad, coffee orders and business paper.

Clr. Hiscock: That's what makes this organisation so great.

16/99 <u>Clr. Verdon</u>: Revised Delivery Plan, still got an issue. Councils, should be changed due to amalgamations and welcomed Clr Braid to RWCC Board.
