- c) The Council resolves that all minerals on the land be excluded from the compulsory acquisition;
- d) The Council resolves that the Valuer General be engaged to value the land for compensation purposes for the compulsory acquisition and compensation be paid in accordance with this valuation; and
- e) Authority be and is hereby given to affix the Council's Seal on any documentation required for the acquisition process.

#### Oaklands:

10/19 RESOLVED on the motion of Clrs. Vidler and Brown that the report on Integrated Water Cycle Management be received and noted.

### **QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS**

10/20 <u>CIr. McInerney</u>: Asked if the rolling meter reading timetable could be adjusted. In Holbrook the electricity and gas meters are read at the same time as water. If the water bills were staggered there would be less financial impact on customers who receive numerous bills at the same time.

General Manager: Will take on notice.

10/21 <u>CIr. Ros</u>s: When attending Greater Hume's Council meeting in Walla Walla he observed that the water quality was not very good.

<u>Director of Engineering</u>: Bores at Walla Walla are problematic and we have looked at various options. A substantial upgrade may be required on water treatment process.

- 10/22 <u>CIr. Goodlass</u>: Thanked Riverina Water for new facility at Tarcutta and congratulated Council on holding a good event yesterday. Also noticed that the gents toilet here is running unnecessarily and could we investigate waterless urinals.
- 10/23 <u>CIr. Brown</u>: Congratulations to management and staff on yesterday's event at Tarcutta, good job, large number of staff in attendance. Good idea having a staff member to give an overview of the system to those in attendance. Media coverage missing, suggest sending press release "truly innovative what's happened at Tarcutta \$1M spent on 340+ people".
- 10/24 <u>CIr. Yates</u>: Referred to Item 1 in Business Paper investments with Wagga Mutual Credit Union and Westpac. Riverina Water does derive income from rural areas, suggest looking at investing with a rural bank eg Bendigo Bank. Can we afford to invest/borrow from Bendigo Bank.

<u>General Manager</u>: Will take on board and advised that he has spoken to Bendigo Bank, but at this stage not offering rates we require.

<u>CIr. Yates</u>: With profits they make, a bit more tolerance of say 0.5%, would help sustainability and support of rural communities?.

10/25 <u>CIr. Yates</u>: I believe the policy we have in regard to water connections for rural consumers paying off over 3 years in some cases is too harsh. Some smaller rural properties are paying up to \$40-60,000 to get water connected and they can't pass the cost on like subdividers can. Possibly spread loan over 5 – 10 years or separate water usage fees.

<u>Chairperson</u>: General Manager will bring back report to Council. Currently prospective consumers pay full cost, with interest free loan over 3 years. Hopefully interest in connections will lessen when drought conditions are less severe.

10/26 <u>CIr. Kreutzberger</u>: Regarding Walla bores. There is good quality water coming from the state government bore which is 7 km from Walla near Morgan's Lookout. This may be worth investigating.

Chairperson: General Manager will investigate.

10/27 <u>CIr. Vidler</u>: Tarcutta has an innovative new water treatment plant based on Council looking at filters in Perth some time ago. Hopefully the people at Tarcutta appreciate what they've got.

### **COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE**

10/28 RESOLVED on the motion of Clrs. Ross and Geale OAM that Council now resolve itself into a Committee-of-the-Whole, to consider General Manager's Contract of Employment.
